PUEBLO OF POJOAQUE HISTORY

The Pueblo of Pojoaque is one of the Six Northern Tewa Speaking pueblos with a population of over 500. Long ago, Pojoaque or "Po-suwae-geh" was a major stop for people to gather their water while traveling. The water was collected from the many springs that exist throughout the area as well as the rivers that meet. The pueblo was re-established in 1932 by 14 people, after the pueblo existed without an organized government for about 20 years. In the 1970s Pojoaque began efforts to revive its culture. In 1973, the pueblo danced their traditional dances for the first time in over 100 years. Towa Golf Course was opened in 2001, pre-dating Buffalo Thunder Resort and Casino as well as Homewood Suites. The Butterfly symbol contains vertical lines signifying the two rivers as well as a circular symbol meaning the "gathering place." In the Tewa language Towa means "The People".

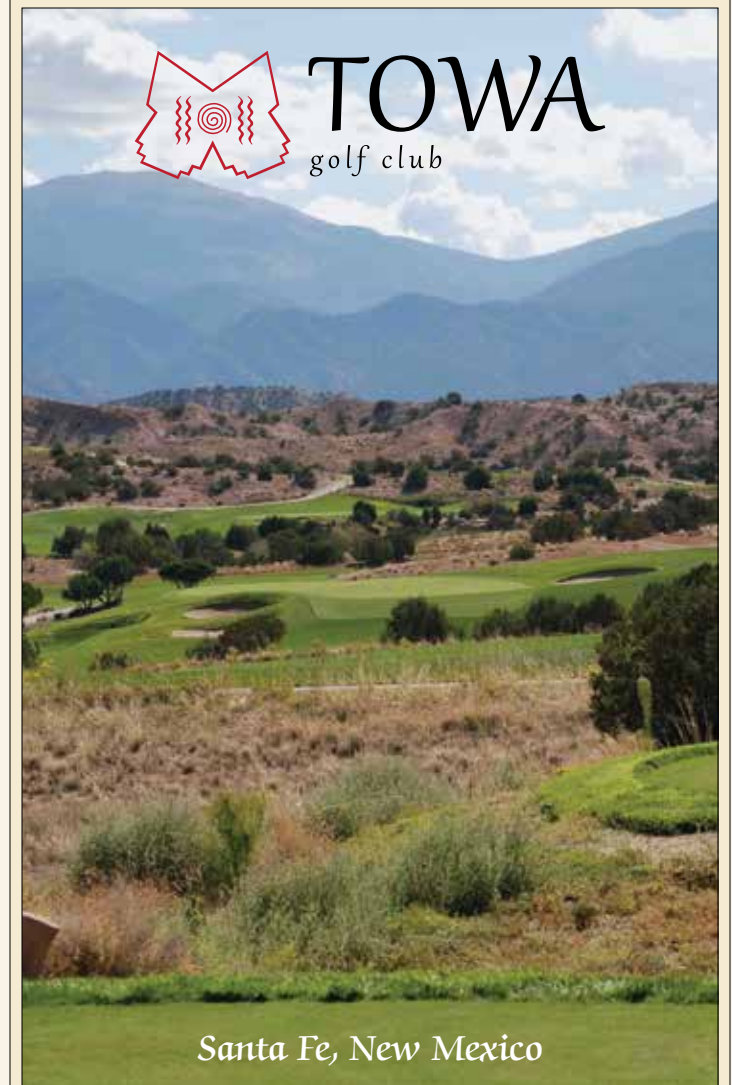
